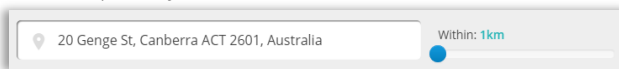




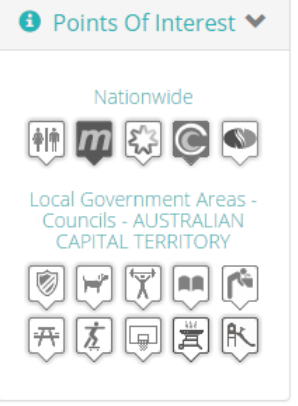
Access My Community is a free 'mapping tool' where you can easily search the Canberra Region for organizations and services.
